Cr: = Crops in **St:** = Stores until **S.F.** = Self fertile

E = Eater

C = Cooker

Rootstocks are listed– Fruit trees are grown on a range of root stocks which control growth rate;

MM106 / SJA / QA.....semi vigorous (up to 4m)
M26 / Pixysemi dwarf (up to 3m)
M9 / Gis5 / QC.....dwarf (2-3m)
M27.....very dwarf (up to 2m)

'Waldo' Mid season, thornless, high yields and large fruits. £ 5.99

Blackcurrant

'Ben Alder' Mid season, late flowering. Good cropper. £ 4.99

'Ben Connan' Early season with large fruits. £ 4.99

'Ben Tirran' Late season and high yielding. £ 4.99

Blueberry

Blueberries require lime-free soil. They do well in pots (using Ericaceous compost) or can be planted approx. 1.5m (5ft.) apart. They flower in spring and produce delicious blue fruits from mid July. Fruiting is improved if more than one variety is grown. The leaves give good autumn colours.

'Blue Jay' Vigorous growth and medium sized fruits with a mild flavour.. £ 7.99

'Gold Traube' Upright habit and succulent fruits. £ 7.99

'Northland' Very productive with well flavoured, medium sized fruits. £ 7.99

Cranberry 'Pilgrim' Large red berries ripen in autumn. Requires lime free soil. £ 7.99

'Hinnomaki Green' Green culinary variety. Mildew resistant. £ 5.99

'Hinnomaki Red' Sweet red fruits. Mildew resistant. £ 5.99

'Invicta' Large, green, culinary variety. Mildew resistant. £ 5.99

'Whinham's Industry' Dessert variety with sweet red fruit. £ 5.99

Jostaberry Thornless gooseberry / blackcurrant cross. Large black fruits. £ 5.99

Loganberry Blackberry / raspberry cross. Long, dark red fruit July / August. £ 5.99
