Hedging - Autumn / Winter 2009

Most of the hedging is bare root stock which can be planted from late October to April. Where the stock is cell grown or potted it is marked accordingly. Please do not hesitate to contact us if the size or variety of hedging you require is not listed. We hope to have a wide selection available most of the time but availability cannot be guaranteed unless pre-ordered. Spacing for most hedging plants is 30-60cm. (12/24") Large evergreens approx. 100cm (3') and small evergreens such as Box 20-30cm (8/12")

Orders will be accepted until the end of January.

Acer campestre "Field Maple"	Frequently used in mixed hedges. Good for coastal and exposed sites. Clear yellow autumn colour.	60/90cm	£ 7.99
Alnus glutinosa "Alder"	Deciduous, shrubby tree bearing catkins in late winter. Tolerant of most conditions including wet sites.	60/90cm	£ 7.99
Carpinus betulus "Hornbeam"	Similar to beech. Leaves are more pointed, turn brown and retained well into the winter. Any soil type, even chalk.	60/90cm	£ 9.99
Crataegus monogyna "Hawthorn"	Tolerant of exposed site and all soil types. White flowers in spring followed by red berries. An excellent hedging plant.	60/90cm	£ 7.99
Cornus sanguinea "Dogwood"	Green stems turn red in winter with good autumn colour. Thrives in damp situations. Good in mixed hedges.	60/90cm	£ 7.99
Corylus avellana "Hazel"	Multi stemmed shrub for most soil types. Yellow catkins in spring and yellow autumn colour.	60/90cm	£ 8.99
Euonymus europaeus "Spindle"	Green stems and deep red autumn leaves. Seed capsules attractive to birds. Vigorous and chalk tolerant.	60/90cm	£ 7.99
Fagus sylvatica "Beech"	Superb plant for hedging. Golden yellow autumn colour. Tolerant of shade and all but heavy, wet soils. Purple form has coppery foliage.	Green 60/90cm Purple 40/60cm	£ 12.99 £ 24.99
Hippophae rhamnoides "Sea Buckthorn"	Bushy plant with silvery leaves. Small orange berries in autumn. Good for coastal planting.	60/90cm	£ 10.99
Malus sylvestris "Crab Apple"	Small pink/white flowers in spring, then green/red fruits. Good in mixed hedges and any type of soil.	60/90cm	£ 8.99
Prunus spinosa "Blackthorn"	Excellent hedging plant with dense, spiny branches. Small white flowers in spring followed by small blue-black fruits (sloes).	60/90cm	£ 7.99
Rosa canina "Dog Rose"	Strong prickly stems, scented, pinkish-white flowers and bright red, egg-shaped "hips". Good for mixed hedges.	60/90cm	£ 7.99
Rosa rubiginosa "Sweet Briar"	Vigorous, dense and prickly. Fragrant pink flowers all summer. Long lasting red fruits. Also known as "Eglantine"	60/90cm	£ 8.99
Rosa rugosa "Ramanas Rose"	Strong, dense and prickly. Fragrant purplish-pink flowers and red fruits. Excellent for coastal planting.	60/90cm	£ 8.99
Rosa pimpinellifolia "Burnet or Scotch Rose"	Small, dense, prickly shrub with small pinkish-white flowers and red-black fruits. A common plant of coastal areas.	60/90cm	£ 9.99
Sambucus nigra "Elder"	Large shrub with fragrant creamy flowers in June, followed by shiny black fruits used for wine making. Any soil type.	60/90cm	£ 7.99
Viburnum opulus "Guelder Rose"	Vigorous shrub bearing white flowers and red fruits. Tolerant of wet, boggy conditions. Excellent in mixed hedges.	60/90cm	£ 7.99
Argyll Hedge Mix	Our selection of mixed hedging will attract a wide variety of wildlife. About half of the mix will be Hawthorn and Blackthorn with the remainder a selection of plants chosen to provide as much year round interest as possible.	60/90cm	£ 7.99

Evergreen Hedging

Buxus sempervirens "Box"	Ideal for small formal hedges and commonly used for topiary. Small dark leaves. For most soil types.	15/20cm	£ 18.99
Escallonia rubra	Vigorous grower with small crimson flowers in summer. Particularly good in coastal areas.	2 litre pot 30/40cm	£ 46.99
Ilex aquifolium "Holly"	Dense, thorny and decorative. Tolerant of most soils and conditions, sun or shade.	9cm pot 15/25cm	£ 29.99
Ligustrum ovalifolium "Privet"	Excellent plant for most soils and situations. Tolerant of coastal conditions. Semi-evergreen in very cold winters.	60/90cm	£ 10.99
Prunus laurocerasus "Laurel"	Dense & vigorous with glossy leaves. Good for screening shelter or game coverts and any soil except chalk.	9cm pot 20/30cm Rootball 50/60cm	£ 19.99 each £ 7.99
Taxus baccata "Common Yew"	For any fertile soil in sun or shade. Excellent for hedging or topiary. All parts of the plant are poisonous.	30/40cm Rootball 40/50cm	£ 31.99 each £ 10.99
Thuja 'Brabant'	An excellent dark green conifer that is very hardy and suitable for all types of soil and conditions. Can be cut back hard and regenerates quickly.	Rootball 80/100cm " 120/140cm	each £ 7.99 each £ 18.99

All bare root hedging plants are subject to a delivery charge of £ 18.00 regardless of the size of the order.

Spacing for most hedging plants is 30 - 60cm. (12 - 24"). Double staggered rows can be planted for a thicker hedge with wider spacing and 45 - 60cm. (18 -24") between the rows. Plants for dwarf hedges, such as Box, should be spaced about 10 -15cm. (4 - 6") apart.
