Eucalyptus archeri "Alpine Cider Gum"	Smooth white/grey bark with green patches. Small grey-green leaves and purple young stems. Very hardy, coppices well and tolerant of exposure. Medium to fast growth.	60/90cm	
Eucalyptus dalrympleana "Mountain Gum"	Cream, brown or grey patchwork bark. Young shoots orange or scarlet. Lime tolerant. Fast growing.	60/90cm	
Eucalyptus gunnii "Cider Gum"	Peeling bark is greenish-grey and orange, creamy-white beneath. Very hardy. Coppices well. Very fast growing.	60/90cm	
Eucalyptus nichollii "Narrow-leaved Black Peppermint"	Fine drooping foliage and pendulous branches. Blue-green, willow-like leaves. Easily pruned to keep as an attractive small tree for a sheltered site.	60/90cm	
Eucalyptus niphophila "Alpine Snow Gum"	Snakeskin bark, grey, green and cream. Scimitar-shaped leaves. Very hardy. Tolerates exposure & salt winds. Slow to medium growth.	60/90cm	
Eucalyptus perriniana "Spinning Gum"	Peeling bark of grey-brown. The stem grows through the circular blue-grey leaves which then "spin". Very hardy. Coppices well. Tolerates exposure. Medium growth rate.	60/90cm	
Eucryphia x intermedia	Lovely fast growing evergreen. Masses of white flowers in July and August. Thrives in a sheltered situation in neutral to lime free soil.	50/60cm	£ 9.49
