Acer rufinerve "Grey-budded Snake-bark Maple"	Medium sized deciduous tree with arching branches, green and white striped bark and brilliant red and orange autumn colours. Origin: Japan.	120/150cm	£ 16.99	
Acer sieboldianum	Small deciduous shrubby tree with finely-toothed leaves. Yellow flowers in spring and rich autumn colours. Origin: Japan.	90/120cm	£ 19.99

Enkianthus perulatus	Slow growing compact medium sized shrub. Masses of urn-shaped white flowers in spring and intense scarlet autumn colours. For lime-free soil. Origin: Japan.	40/60cm	£ 9.99

Eucryphia cordifolia "Ulmo"	Beautiful large evergreen shrub which between July and September bears large white flowers with conspicuous stamens. Thrives best in a sheltered position and neutral to lime-free moist loamy soil. Origin: Chile.	10/20cm	£ 9.99
Eucryphia x intermedia "Rostrevor"	Large deciduous shrub/small tree of erect habit. Masses of large white flowers smother the branches July / August and are followed by good autumn colours.	60/90cm	£ 9.99

Fagus sylvatica "Black Swan"	Medium sized deciduous tree of compact weeping habit with very dark leaves which open brown and become almost black within a few weeks. Tolerant of most soil types .	150/180cm	£ 48.99
Fagus sylvatica "Dawyck Gold"	Golden leaved form of the "Dawyck Beech". A dense narrow column with bright yellow leaves - spectacular in spring.	90/120cm	£ 33.99
Fagus sylvatica "Dawyck Purple"	Narrower and less dense than the golden form this has splendid deep purple foliage.	90/120cm	£ 33.99

Fraxinus excelsior "Pendula" "Weeping Ash"	Strong growing deciduous tree. Forms a wide spreading mound of weeping branches with long shoots to the ground. Tolerant of most soils and situations including coastal exposure.	150/180cm NMO	£ 39.99
Hamamelis x intermedia "Diana" "Witch Hazel"	Large deciduous spreading shrub bearing scented red spider-like flowers in February and rich autumn leaf colour. All are best in neutral to acid soil and tolerant of sun or shade.	90/120cm	£ 45.99
Hamamelis x int. "Jelena"	This form is more vigorous and had coppery-orange scented flowers in February and red autumn leaf colour.	90/120cm	£ 45.99
Hamamelis x intermedia "Pallida"	One of the most popular Witch Hazels with large sulphur-yellow sweetly scented flowers early in the year. Yellow autumn colour.	90/120cm	£ 45.99
Hydrangea petiolaris "Climbing Hydrangea"	Strong growing self-clinging deciduous climber. Excellent on north facing or shady walls and in suitable trees. Flowers are white and greenish-white in June. Can also be grown as a shrub.	60/90cm	£ 9.49
Hydrangea 'Preziosa'	Handsome deciduous shrub with purplish-red stems and purple-tinged young leaves. Rounded heads of rose-pink florets in summer deepen to reddish-purple in autumn.	40/60cm	£ 7.99

Sorbus aria 'Lutescens'	Attractive small deciduous tree with silvery young leaves that mature to grey-green. White flowers in spring are followed by orange-red fruits. Russet/gold autumn colours.	90/120cm	£ 22.99
Sorbus aucuparia "Rowan" or "Mountain Ash"	Small to medium sized deciduous tree. A familiar native with pinnate leaves and greyish winter buds. Autumn fruits bright red in large clusters. Tolerates extreme acidity. (See also our list of native and common trees.)	90/120cm	£ 22.99
Sorbus cashmiriana	Beautiful small deciduous tree. Pink flowers in May are followed by long lasting gleaming white fruits. Origin: Kashmir.	90/120cm	£ 25.99
Sorbus folgeri 'Lemon Drop'	Small graceful deciduous tree with slender arching branches. Bright yellow fruits & deep green leaves that are white beneath.	90/120cm	£ 23.99

Abies alba "Silver Fir"	Very large tree with smooth grey bark when young. Cylindrical green/brown cones. Origin: Europe.	40/60cm	£ 7.99
Abies concolor "Colorado White Fir"	Beautiful large tree with smooth grey bark. Leaves blue-green or grey-green. Not for shallow chalk soil. Origin: U.S.A.	40/60cm	£ 7.99
Abies delavayi	Handsome, medium sized tree. Bright shiny green leaves have silver undersides. Cones are bluish-violet.	30/40cm	£ 9.99

Abies grandis "Giant Fir"	Large, fast growing tree with fragrant, shining green leaves and attractive cones. Tolerant of shade. W. North America.	50/70cm	£ 6.99

Abies sibirica "Siberian Fir"	Large tree with soft grass-green leaves. Cylindrical cones are bluish when young, 5 - 7cm long (2 - 3")	50/80cm	£ 8.99
Araucaria araucana "Monkey Puzzle"	Large evergreen tree of unique appearance. Widely planted in Victorian times. An excellent wind resister. Does best in moist, well drained, loamy soil. Origin: Chile, Argentina.	20/30cm	£ 10.49
Calocedrus decurrans "Incense Cedar"	Large evergreen of columnar habit. The dark green leaves are held in dense fan-like sprays. Effective as a single specimen or in groups. Origin: W. North America.	40/60cm	£ 8.99
Cedrus atlantica "Atlas Cedar"	Large evergreen tree of rapid growth when young. Grey-green leaves borne on horizontal branches. Origin: Atlas Mts.	80/100cm	£ 14.99
